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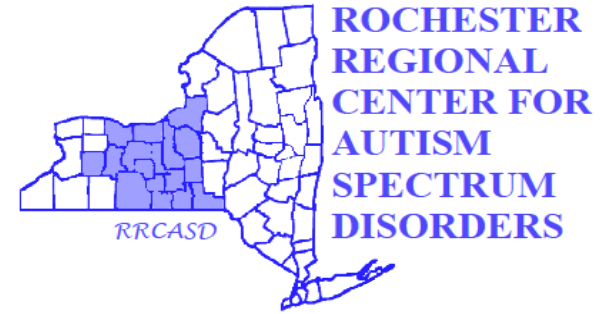

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About the Speaker

Caroline I Magyar, Ph.D. is an Associate Professor, Department of Pediatrics & Director, Rochester Regional Center for Autism Spectrum Disorders, University of Rochester. Dr. Magyar's clinical work focuses on assessment & treatment of ASD. Her research includes program evaluation of educational treatment models and psychological assessment in ASD and comorbid disorders. Dr. Magyar is the recipient of numerous grants in the areas of personnel preparation, community education and technical assistance, and assessment and treatment of ASD. Dr. Magyar has authored a book on ASD educational program development and evaluation, and co-authored several chapters and papers on the assessment and treatment of ASD.

Talk Description

In the past two years, there has been an increased focus on understanding and addressing the needs of adults with ASD. This information is needed to inform not only our clinical practices, but also our public policies and funding priorities as we seek to develop a variety of programs and services to meet the needs of adults with ASD. However, there is little research to guide us in understanding what constitutes effective clinical practices for assessing and treating ASD in adults, or the types of programs and services that are likely to be effective. This presentation will review the latest information on ASD in adulthood and the unique and diverse support needs associated with this phase of life. Information will be presented on the characteristics of ASD in adulthood, considerations in clinical assessment and treatment practices, and identifying and accessing adult programs and services within the region.
